In Hawaii

Pacific Autism Center provides a school placement option for parents of both preschoolers ages 3 to 6 and older children, ages 6 and up. In addition, we have a contract with the Department of Health to provide IBS services for the 0-3 population.

The school day for both the Preschool and the Learning Center start at 8:00 a.m. and ends at 2:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday. We also provide services in the home some evenings and on Saturdays.



Peer Group

We have an inclusion peer group called Roads to Learning. Typically developing children go to this peer group and have their own teacher and structured curriculum to meet their needs. Autistic children who enter the center will have intensive individual programs developed that are specifically based on that child's unique needs. They will integrate into the peer group throughout the day as appropriate.

Learning Center



The Learning Center is for older students who need intensive instruction or specialized programs. The other rooms we have as part of the Learning Center are a classroom, a computer room, a small library, a lunch area, a speech and language room, two pull-out rooms and a play room to work on play skills. We offer programs for students during school breaks and during the summer time we also provide a comprehensive program.

In Japan

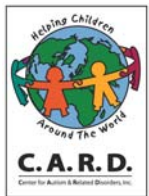
PAC started earlier this year providing services to children in Japan. In an effort to be responsive to the needs there in Japan, children have attended our Hawaii center for several weeks to obtain services and consultation.

Consulting

We have several highly qualified consultants that visit Japan every other month so as to supplement programs and meet with teams.

Tuition

The school's tuition generally covers all services listed which includes a 40 hour a week individualized ABA program, 30 provided in the school environment and 10 in the home. In addition it includes supervision by our on-site ABA programmer, our supervisors, OT, Speech therapy, fieldtrip generalization programs, materials, reinforcers, and school placement for an entire calendar year.



Tuition is based on the individualized needs of the children and is developed based on specific needs and services. All costs are equivalent to fees the department of education currently pays for these services.

Curriculum
